Working arrangement

The position is a Contrat à Durée Déterminée (project-based CDD of one year in accordance with the French regulation in terms of social security, holidays, etc.). Confirmation of the appointment will take place after a two-month probation period (renewable once). It is a full-time position, which annual salary is based on qualifications and experience of the candidate as well as on the salary grid of ACTeon. The position is located in Colmar (France – 30 minutes by public transport from Strasbourg or Basel) with (partial) teleworking being part of ACTeon's current working arrangements. The position requires short term travel in France and abroad (mainly in Europe). Starting date (tentative): at the earliest. The successful candidate will be a part of an inspiring team of 20 professionals working in a wide range of collaborative research and consultancy projects mobilizing (research, consultancy, public bodies, civil society...) partners from different European communities of practice.
